Aimlessly Drifting

Are you aimlessly drifting through life?
You could be and not even aware of it!

We may have eyes to guide us, but most of us stumble around this world drifting and aimlessly living out day after day, unsure of each road and path we choose to take, only hoping for the best, while waiting the outcome.

The roads and path way that we choose to take in life, for most of us, is learned behavior handed down throughout the generations. For some of us, unfortunate circumstances have driven us onto a path that is less than fulfilling and desirable.

I'm sure if most of us took the time out to evaluate, we certainly would change our situation, but instead we keep drifting further and further away, day after day.

It's been said that we possess 5 senses:

see, hear, touch, taste and smell.

Do we actually have these five Senses?

I tell you we have more!

Let's take the first sense, See/Sight (Your Guide)

The way you view yourself, and your circumstance is the way you continue to live your life day after day, with no attempt to change yourself or your situation.

If we view ourselves as powerless in a hopeless situation, if we view ourselves as weak, if we view ourselves as a grasshopper in a world of giants, we can't change our circumstances because we are limited to our vision, and our vision is fixated only upon what we see, or how we perceive ourselves. If you can't visualize a new path, or a new way of life, you certainly can't explore it! It's like living your life in a vicious circle going around and around, never getting to greener pasture.

Throughout the centuries there were men who took first steps, down new roads, armed with nothing but their own vision. Ayn Rand

Many years ago, while diligently seeking for a new job, career, income, or whatever you would like to call it, I recall being asked by every interviewer; Where do you see yourself 5 years from now? I can remember how I dreading the question, and how days before the interview, I would try to think of something clever to say.

I couldn't think of one clever make believe, super person to tell them that I was, and what I wanted to become, not to mention, five years seemed like a lifetime away. I couldn't visualize next week, forget the next five years: anyway, I never came up with anything impressive that convinced me, and if I couldn't convince myself, how could I convince anyone else? The reason it was so hard for me to answer that question, I now realize, that I honestly didn't know. I was aimlessly drifting through life, just looking for any income to survive, feed, clothe and shelter my child, having no real direction.

The desire for a better life is always a passing thought for everyone, but to actually pursue it takes effort and a vision. I lacked a real vision, so I wasn't sure who I was, or where I was headed.

I had no clue what type of job, or career that I sincerely wanted, or what I wanted to achieve in my life.

I don't know about you, but I'm not a good liar, I'm better at avoiding the question or being vague. I'm actually very transparent.

Over the course of my life, I've made some unintelligent decisions, many mistakes and bad choices, so I guess I was, as they say, paying penance by suffering the consequences, drifting through life being tossed around like a ball in a pinball machine, bracing for the next wall that may come up against.

It's sort of as if you were lost and traveling around and around for hours, days, months, years and ending up in the exact, same spot that you started, nothing accomplished, only time lost.

The children of Israel traveled in the desert for 40 years, in circles, when in actuality it should have only taken them one hour to get out. They were told about the land of milk and honey, but they couldn't grasp the vision, because they couldn't let go of Egypt. Even though Egypt was hardship, even though Egypt was less than desirable, it was familiar, and they became accustomed to that lifestyle, comfortable, and tolerated their situation year after year. They accepted in their minds and their hearts they had no power to change it, but all the while, God heard their prayers, and saw their afflictions, they were more important to God than they realized.

They were created with purpose, and that was not to slave for Egypt.

The same as each of us were created with purpose, and not to be enslaved to hardship for anything or anyone. Having no vision of who you are in Christ, and what you can accomplish through him, you are more likely to continue to drift aimlessly throughout your entire life, never being fulfilled or satisfied with who you truly are, or knowing your purpose in life.

And my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, said the Lord. Jeremiah 31-14

Rut: A fixed, usually boring routine.

We'll refer to the following families as the rut families. The rut families go through life day after day sticking to the familiar, the safe, the memorized ruts, doing the same things day after day.

They can perform daily tasks with their eyes closed, maybe not as quickly as with sight, but nevertheless they could accomplish it, because they visualize it in their mind.

We have our ritual lifestyle embedded in our minds eye, and that's all we can focus upon.

The way of peace they don't know, and there is not judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goes there shall not know peace. Isaiah 59:8

Try this exercise (a) Exercise Everyone knows his or her home fairly well. Have someone blindfold you, and close a couple doors in your home, leaving a few open, without telling you which are open or closed, try to maneuver about your home as quickly in and out of every room, as you could if you're eyes were wide open.

You can't! Now try to make a sandwich, or get dressed. Not an easy task. I'm sure you could accomplish it, but not as quickly, or as confident, as efficient, or as quickly as you could if you were approaching the task with eyes wide open.

If I asked the rut family, where will you be in 5 years from now, God willing we have 5 years, most would be doing the same things in life that their doing now, good or bad, some of them could not answer at all, because the only vision they have is the routine that has been embedded in their mind that causes them to only co-existing.

We were not created to co-exist or let the cookie crumble, or the crumbs fall wherever they may, or going through life with the attitude of whatever happens, happens! No, our life is worth more than that! Our existence is far more important than to aimlessly drift throughout our entire life co-existing, or in an apathy state.

In all thy ways acknowledge him and he shall direct thy path. Proverbs 3:6

Co-existing

Co-existing: (a) To exist together at the same time, or in the same place (b) To live in peace with another or others despite differences, especially as a matter of policy.

Are you co-existing?

This is both a good thing and a bad thing!

Although we all have to live together on the same planet, and hopefully most of us do want to coexist together in peace and harmony, there has to be more to one's life than to simply co-exist! If we just co-exist day after day, year after year, we may be closer to living a robotic life, than that of a productive, full, happy life, that we were destined to have.

We were created to have life, and that more abundant I can do all things through Christ, which strengthens me. Philippians 4:13 And my people shall be satisfied with my goodness; said the Lord Jeremiah 31:14

Are You Robotic?

See how robotic you are...

Try these exercises. (1) Writing down your daily rituals. Looking over your daily routine will help determine if you're robotic. You might be robotic if: 5 days out of your week are exactly the same. Weekends may also be exactly the same.

If you're one of the lucky robots, you may have the weekends off work, but nevertheless, you are still working with no time left for yourself. You're so exhausted from being a robot for 5 days that the weekend passes you by so quickly there's hardly time to catch your breath before returning to your robotic state.

How much time do you have for yourself? How much time do you spend with our spouse? How much time do you spend with your children, how about God? We have to have a balance in life, or someone, or something will suffer, and sever consequences will be paid.

If you're too busy for yourself and God, you're too busy! Robots are programmed, just as some people have become a programmed robot, laying aside their true feelings, and desires to please someone else, or accomplish a never-ending task that's meaningless and without reward.

(2) Observe the face of individuals as you travel to and from work, as you shop, count the number of faces you see smiling as their robotic state experiences a small interference, and becomes in contact with the outside realm of their programmed world.

We walk through life emotionless; the face of numerous people are masked, just going through life from morning to night, following the same pattern or schedules they've formed for themselves, enduring the webs they have woven over time. 3, Now, glance at the face of several people talking on a cell phone, you see them expressing emotion. Some may be smiling, crying or talking fast, but there's emotion, new thoughts are entering their into their hearing and causing them to step outside their programmed world and actually show a real part of themselves.

Yet moments after they disconnect, they slip back to their robotic state. Cell phones may not be bad after all; it may be one of the greatest inventions created!

Some times, the only time, you see a smile on some peoples face, is when they are on their cell phone, and that's because whomever is on the other end is bringing news, or bringing relief to their daily ruts, and rituals, shedding some good news, or joy in their life, breaking up

the monotonous routine that we encounter day after day, bringing a smile to someone's face, even if it's momentarily. It causes them to escape their chaotic life style, and listen to someone else for a little while, bringing separation, some peace, and joy to their hard driven life, their burden spirit

I'm not saying everyone is robotic, but I bet you know a few robots.

I don't mean to sound redundant, but I'm trying to get you to see, and understand, how life can become so redundant, that it over our life, and can causes us to fall into a rut that we cannot find our way out of.

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Matthew 11:28

When our coexistence get us to the point that we're so easily programmable, that we become robotic, or that we're taken advantage of by others, that's not a good thing, and time to seriously take some time out and regroup, re-evaluate our life, do some soul searching and a turnabout

As I try to stress to the youth in my youth outreach, Life is too short, and so precious, be careful not to waste it.

Some of us have out grown our income to the point that we have to work twice harder, or we've spoiled our children so much, that we have to take on an extra job just to satisfy them, and keep them happy. We grow older and more tired, while our children grow lazier and more irresponsible. We spend our entire life working harder to supply their unreasonable requests.

Something is wrong with this way of living.

We are destroying our children and their future

Who are you?

I will be asking you this question periodically, throughout this entire book, for the purpose of monitoring your vision, and watching as you come to realize that you are living your life in a rut and not enjoying the abundant life that you were created to enjoy.

Who are you? I'm not looking for a title such as, a wife, a husband, a Mother, a Father, a sister, a brother, a teacher, or airline pilot, etc. The question's not asking your status or occupation, But, **WHO ARE YOU? WHO ARE YOU WHEN NO ONE ELSE IS WATCHING, or YOU'RE ALONE WITH YOURSELF?**

You can put on a many faces, many personalities, many characters, you can pretend to be happy, but only what's true on the inside is what's important. Many of us live a life of lies. Some of us walk through life with a smile most of the time, entertaining others, but on the inside they're running on empty; that's tears of a clown. Many of us live our life through someone else's eyes, or for someone else, never doing what we truly want to do, or becoming who we truly want to be. We're like a fly caught up in our own web, and we surrender our all, because we feel defeated.

This is not our purpose in life. We were created to have life and that more abundantly. I can't stress this to you enough! When we realize that we are living beneath our privilege, you're worth more than a robot, and there's a way out, your life will change forever. I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. John 10:10

We should be enslaved to no one, or nothing, yes, I know we have to work, we have all perform certain duties in life, but 90 % of the webs that we weave, or that we get caught up in, we stumbled into them our selves because we are without vision. We go through life with our spirit and soul in a robotic state, abating our true self, and our true feelings, unaware of who we are, and are divine purpose in life. We all live harder lives, because we line up with this worlds idea of life, and other peoples standards.

If you have ever watched or observed a child at play, young or older, their imagination can take them wherever they choose to go.

They actually seem to visualize, or pretend to be whom ever they desire; a fairy princess, a fireman, spider man or superman, they have no limitations, no boundaries, because their vision, their imagination is very real, they are able to be extraordinary and invincible for many years.

Some even think they can fly, and try it! If you want to know who you are today, or what you're made of, check out the word seeds that have been planted in your hearing over time, sometimes we are our own worse enemy, and speak nothing but negative word seeds into our own hearing. When we say things to ourselves, as all of us have done, words like, I'm so stupid, I feel sick, or I'm never going to do this and that, or be this or that, or have this and that, guess what, you're not!

Word Seeds and Harvest

It's the adult, or authority figure that begins to instill (plant seeds) fears and doubts into the young and undeveloped mind, placing limitation and boundaries in their life, unaware of the hope, and faith they maybe robbing this child of.

When you tell someone they can't do something enough, no matter how much they once believed that they could, after awhile, they believe that they can't.

You can apply this concept applies to almost anything, positive or negative. If you know anything about seed-time and harvest, you know that when a seed is planted, it grows. If you plant a pumpkin seed, don't expect an apple tree.

Words are like seeds, when planted, they grow!

You are who you say, and believe you are, or what others have said in your hearing over and over. Never let anyone manipulate or ridicule you, God created us all and you are just as good if not better than the one who is intimidating you.

Most of us value others opinion so much, that we start to absorb their word seeds into our mind, our heart and our spirit and eventually we carry it out. Those word seeds have taken root, and grown into who you are today. The ears that are filled with compliments, encouragement and praise, are more than likely to be happy and successful, than the ears that have been ridiculed, discouraged, manipulated and intimidated throughout life.

Words are like seeds, when planted in your mind and spirit they grow. What sort of crops, are growing in your life? What seeds have you sown in other peoples life?

The seeds that are planted in our life, by ourselves, or by those we love and trusted, can sometimes grow up and surround us like tall fields of doubt and fears. If we become so nearsighted that we can only believe what we see, and what we see is hopeless, we will perish, for without vision, you will perish!

Let's take the second sense. (Hearing) What we allow to enter into our hearing travels to our mind, forming images, which continues to travel to our sight, and our sight guides us through life. We will always follow or act out the images that we entertain. Have you ever thought about a certain food? You first think of that food, or hear about it, you entertain the idea, and soon you start to desire it. Words do form images, and images become reality in our mind. If I say banana, did you just visualize a banana. If I say ocean, did you just visualize the ocean in your mind's eye? When we communicate with individuals who have lost their physical eyesight, they see or vision the words that are taken into their hearing. If we say airplane, restaurant, ice cream, etc. they may not have ever physically seen one, but the word forms a vision and they are able to visualize it in their mind.

Words have power death and life are in the power of the tongue: proverbs 18:21

If we walk by sight and not faith, most of us are in a hopeless situation.

We have to learn to live by faith, and not by sight. You can't begin to change your life and your destiny, until you learn to change your words.

Turn the negative into positive.

Speak only the words that you desire to come to pass, and not what you are seeing or feeling at this time in life.

You can curse your life, and your children's life, or you can bless your life, and your children's life with your words..

When the God created the world, he spoke it into existence. The life you are living today is the words that you, or someone else spoke into your life yesterday, last month, last decade, etc.

The tongue is a two edged sword, and cannot be tamed. The bible tells us our mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under our tongue is mischief and vanity, psalm

Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile.

Whosoever keeps his mouth and his tongue keeps his Soul from troubles. Proverbs Word of the Lord

I'm sure each of us have words embedded in our spirits, and in our minds, that were spoken to us in anger or out of spite by someone whom their words had special meaning, or long term effect, upon our lives.

Many parents don't realize it, but in the process of rearing up a child, they look up to you, they depend upon you doing the right things, and speaking the right words into their hearing.

Words are able to build up, or destroy spirits. Our spirit rules our life. Shame on you if you intimidate

deceive, badger, manipulate, or speak harsh devastating and debilitating curse words into your child's life. Shame on you if you don't tell your child daily, that you love them, and how important they are to you.

God gave you this child not to curse, but to bless and to speak love, peace, joy and faith into their lives, to mold them and help them to accomplish great things in life, not to rob them and cause them to feel like a loser, useless to you and the world. Some of the trauma that people experience today in their life, is because of word seeds used to curse them and not to bless them, giving them a sense of self worth, hope, peace and happiness. Words have power, and when they are misused in a harsh way can damage, debilitate and destroy lives.

As a parent or authority figure, it's up to you to make that child feel special, loved and wanted. It's up to you, as an authority figure, to teach a child to believe in you, but more important to believe in themselves!

It's up to you to mold that child in a positive way, helping them to be all that they can be. No, I'm not against discipline, I'm not against hard work or chores, in fact, I believe that the correct discipline, non violent discipline, and chores help mold a child and teach values and responsibilities

However, I am against hitting your spouse, your child or anyone. I am against verbal abuse and manipulating anyone, and God forbid should you ever hurt, molest or murder a child: It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend

One Of these little ones. Luke 17:2 word of the Lord
watch out, You will stand before judgment! Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish

Matthew 18:14.

You were hand Crafted

There's more to us than we realize, If we only believe and have the faith. If we can grab hold of a vision and never let it go, our life will change. Our past is not our future. Our history does not have to be our destiny. Just because we may have been raised on the wrong side of the tracks, doesn't mean we have to continue living there. Most of us were raised in a dysfunctional family, but we do not have to function in a dysfunctional environment. You don't have to live your life with limitation and boundaries. There's more to you than you're allowing to surface.

Every person in this world, from the beginning of time, was born as an innocent baby, knowing very little, but well equipped with God giving talents. If you don't believe this, explain how some very small youngsters have the ability to do things that others cannot, without any training or schooling. Explain how some people have certain talents that others could not learn, if they spent their entire life in school. Explain how some people can sing naturally, and others could not carry a tune in a bucket.

God created each of us with talents that only we can perform.

Each individual possesses special unique talents necessary for us to carry out our life productively and according to his will.

You can be as atheist as you like, you can believe in evolution or any other theory you desire, but if you honestly think about it, it took some super power to create heaven and earth. Each individual is so different, so special, so wonderfully made that nothing but a superior, all mighty God could have created such an awesome circle of life.

The Big bang could not have detailed or hand crafted each individual in such a way. The big bang theory would have created everyone exactly the same. We're all created in the image of the almighty God, with the ability to triumph victoriously over all circumstances. He gave us power over the entire earth. God sent us to this with special gifts, talents, abilities and uniqueness, but unfortunately, some where, somehow, through life you've learned or were taught to suppress your dreams, your desires and your visions. Somehow you have filed away some of your God given gifts, talents and uniqueness that you were equipped with for your journey, or they never properly developed within you.

There is much more to you, than you are giving yourself credit for. You were created with a victorious spirit to be able to over come, to be the head and not the tail, a world changer and a history maker, you can reach deep down inside your spirit and bring it back to life. You just have to push through your limitations, your aggravations, your hesitations, and be all that you can be. Be all that the all mighty God created you to be.

Imagine a child or yourself, well equipped with God given gifts and talents, but totally dependant upon others, such as parents, teachers, aunts, uncles, siblings, etc. in this world to teach them, lead and guide them, rearing them to adulthood, without any prior knowledge or training whatsoever.

Compare yourself to a house that God furnished with his finest hand crafted furniture, and everyone freely came in and redecorated, placing furnishings of their choice, and removing those that were made by the hand of God which made this house beautiful, special and unique.

The house would not be the same as it's original state, making it less effective for those that enter it, taking away the awe, leaving it ordinary instead of extraordinary. My child lives out much of his life on what I taught him, the school taught him, what my family taught him. This behavior is carried out, and passed down generation after generation.

Generational curses

There are generational curses, and generational blessings. Generational curses could play a big part in the actions and decisions that you repeatedly make, over and over.

We must acknowledge this, repent and ask God to break and heal our family of curse and bless us. We are to pray blessings upon our children, and our children's children. If we never had the privilege of blessings prayed over us, as many of us have not, we maybe living a cursed life.

Curses

So the LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, "Cursed are you above all the livestock and all the wild animals! You will crawl on your belly and you will eat dust all the days of your life.

Does the Serpent still crawl upon his belly?

When God speaks it's truth. [Genesis 3:14](#)

To Adam he said, "Because you listened to your wife and ate from the tree about which I commanded you, "You must not eat of it, "Cursed is the ground because of you; through painful toil you will eat of it all the days of your life.

I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you." [Genesis 12:3](#)

[Curses for Disobedience] However, if you do not obey the LORD your God and do not carefully follow all his commands and decrees I am giving you today, all these curses will come upon you and overtake you: The fruit of your womb will be cursed, and the crops of your land, and the calves of your herds and **the lambs Of your flocks.** Deuteronomy 28:18

God's curses are still in effect today. You can continue to pass down these curses, sometimes without the knowledge that it's a curse. Generational curses can be broken and replaced with generational blessings, just as the handcrafted furnishings were replaced in the house that God built, with man made furnishings.

Man made will never equal God made. Now, take 5 minutes, close your eyes and search out who you are or who you have become over time. Is this the person you truly want to be? What do you want out of life? Do you have a vision? Are you following your dreams and living the life that God desires for you?

Do you have an empty void in your heart and life? Do you desire more out of life?

Is there an empty place that you can't seem to fill?

O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trust in him. Psalm 34:8

You can become whatever you desired to be, as long as You're not hurting anyone or breaking God's laws.

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28

Your life can be exceptional and extraordinary if you have the faith, if you have the vision, if your mind is on God and without limitations. If you search out the hand crafted material that God has equipped you with. If you say God didn't give you anything special, God didn't give you talent, God didn't call you to do anything special, you are calling him a liar, because he tells us in his word that he is no respecter of person.

If you don't stand for something, you will fall for anything! If you keep failing or feel like a failure, somewhere in time you have been stripped of your identity and lost sight of your vision, you have forgotten who you are and where you came from, as in the previous chapter. If you tell yourself enough that you're a failure or you can't do this and that, If you tell yourself enough that you can't or will never rise above your circumstances, or that you will always be sick, sad and sorry, guess what, you will and you can't.

There are no failures in this world, only misguided.

There are no losers in this world, only those that have lost their vision and strayed, or rebelled against God and lost the battle. If you never try to change or better yourself, than you can become a self made loser, not from God or by his will, but your own. God has given us everything we need to be the head and not the tail, he has given us everything we need within us, to be victorious, but if we fail to use it or ask him for help, it's our own fault.

Escape Goating

You must use the past to draw strength from it, not weakness, you must use the past to heal the generational curse and not keep using it as a crutch. If you're going to be victorious in your future, you have to overcome the past. If you're blaming everything on your parents and you're an adult, you're using them as your escape-goat for your mistakes and failures. Although many ugly words, seeds of ridiculing and incidents have played a crucial part in your thinking, it's time to bury the past and move on. It's time to take out the trash.

Stop using the escape goat card. From the very beginning of time there has been dysfunction in every family and every generation. Adam and Eve: Eve listened to the serpent and she sinned.

Adam listened to Eve and he sinned. Cain slew Abel and he sinned. The best part, they each blamed each other, and they each became an escape goat. It was from the beginning of time dysfunctional families began, So God's heard it all before.

We're not the first to accuse others for our circumstances and shortcomings, and we won't be the last. You're not an adulterer because your parents were, you're not a liar, thief, cheat, child molester, rapist, murder or fornicator because your parents were, but because you choose to be.

True, you may have learned many bad, hurtful things, many wrong ways from the people you love, but everyone has a choice to do right or wrong.

You're not living in sin because your parents did. You're living in sin because you choose to, or you don't know any better.

You're not uneducated because you're parents were, or because you were poor, what about now?

No, I tell you whatever situation you're caught up in, or your current circumstance that you're in, is because you choose to continue in that condition, or you don't have the hope, faith or knowledge to change it.
It's easier to blame your mother, father, sister, brother, aunt or uncle.

This day I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live Deut30:19

It's easier to blame society, color, race, the president or God, then to take responsibility for your own actions. Your escape goat excuse is nothing new to God; he's heard it all before. It's nothing new to the world; it's been used before. What you need to know is how to change and rise above it

Life will always throw you some curve balls, so rather you're a male or female, you better to learn to play ball. Good news, God made us all great ball players. (God has never created junk) so stop thinking, or saying it's because you were made that way.

Yes, you may have had a life or past that I can't even imagine, or comprehend, but God knows everything and he has eye witnessed, he has heard more than you have been through, or more than you can ever imagine.

The best part is that we don't have to keep on escaping, but we can come to terms with the past and over take it. We can actually use the past to develop our future, and not only develop our future, but reach out and help someone else who may have experienced or going through the same exact thing as you. What or who makes a good preacher or teacher?

Those that have first hand knowledge and experience. That's called a talent; use your talent or experiences as a gift!

- You have to recognize bad unhealthy relationships, and cut yourself loose from them. To start a new future you have to deal with the past and put it behind you.
- * You have to understand that messages (words) from your childhood, and the past are playing a part in your life today. This step is so important.

You have to change your attitude and your words. God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

Psalm 46:1

And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark seasons and days and years and God said, "Let the water teem with living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the expanse of the sky." * I'm hoping you are getting the point..
